GOOD DISPLAY

1. General Description

GDEP133UT3-T is a reflective electrophoretic E-ink technology display module with capacitive touch screen, based on active matrix TFT substrate. It has 13.3" active area with 1600 x 1200 pixels, the display is capable to display images at 2-16 gray levels (1-4 bits) depending on the display controller and the associated waveform file.





- The maximum power consumption is measured at 75 Hz operation with following pattern transition: from pattern of repeated 1 consecutive black scan lines followed by 1 consecutive white scan line to that of repeated 1 consecutive white scan lines followed by 1 consecutive black scan lines.(Note 6-1)
- The Typical power consumption is measured using 50Hz waveform with following pattern transition: from horizontal 4 gray scale pattern to vertical 4 gray scale pattern. (Note 6-2)
- The standby power is the consumed power when the panel controller is in standby mode.
- The listed electrical/optical characteristics are only guaranteed under the controller & waveform provided by Good Display.
- Vcom is recommended to be set in the range of assigned value $\pm 0.1V$.
- The rush current is for reference only.




OUTPUT LATCH CONTROL SIGNALS




CLOCK & DATA TIMING

6-5) Controllers Timing




Figure 1 Line Timing in Mode 3




Figure 2 Frame Timing in Mode 3

The timing mode is depicted on Figure 1 and Figure 2 and it refers to timing of Source Driver Output Enable (SDOE)⁽³⁾ and Gate Driver Clock (GDCK)⁽³⁾. Note, the controller timing in the mode LGON follows GDCK timing.

7. Power on Sequence


Power Rails must be sequenced in the following order :

1. VSS → VDD → VNEG → VPOS (Source driver) → VCOM
2. VSS → VDD → VGL → VGH (Gate driver)


Note:

- VGL should be turned off after VNEG and VPOS have been turned off and returned to the ground state
- VGL should be turned off after the Vcom has been turned off and returned to the ground state.
- All of Vcom/VNEG/VPOS/VGN/VGL MUST turn off right after data transfer completes.





8-2) Definition of contrast ratio

The contrast ratio (CR) is the ratio between the reflectance in a full white area (RI) and the reflectance in a dark area (Rd): $CR = RI / Rd$



8-3) Reflection Ratio

The reflection ratio is expressed as:

$R = \text{Reflectance Factor}_{\text{white board}} \times (L_{\text{center}} / L_{\text{white board}})$

L_{center} is the luminance measured at center in a white area ($R=G=B=1$).

$L_{\text{white board}}$ is the luminance of a standard white board. Both are measured with equivalent illumination source. The viewing angle shall be no more than 2 degrees.

9. HANDLING, SAFETY AND ENVIROMENTAL REQUIREMENTS AND REMARK

WARNING
The display glass may break when it is dropped or bumped on a hard surface. Handle with care. Should the display break, do not touch the electrophoretic material. In case of contact with electrophoretic material, wash with water and soap.

CAUTION
The display module should not be exposed to harmful gases, such as acid and alkali gases, which corrode electronic components.
Disassembling the display module can cause permanent damage and invalidate the warranty agreements.
IPA solvent can only be applied on active area and the back of a glass. For the rest part, it is not allowed.

Mounting Precautions
(1) It's recommended that you consider the mounting structure so that uneven force (ex. Twisted stress) is not applied to the module.
(2) It's recommended that you attach a transparent protective plate to the surface in order to protect the EPD. Transparent protective plate should have sufficient strength in order to resist external force.
(3) You should adopt radiation structure to satisfy the temperature specification.
(4) Acetic acid type and chlorine type materials for the cover case are not desirable because the former generates corrosive gas of attacking the PS at high temperature and the latter causes circuit break by electro-chemical reaction.
(5) Do not touch, push or rub the exposed PS with glass, tweezers or anything harder than HB pencil lead. And please do not rub with dust clothes with chemical treatment. Do not touch the surface of PS for bare hand or greasy cloth. (Some cosmetics deteriorate the PS)
(6) When the surface becomes dusty, please wipe gently with absorbent cotton or other soft materials like chamois soaks with petroleum benzene. Normal-hexane is recommended for cleaning the adhesives used to attach the PS. Do not use acetone, toluene and alcohol because they cause chemical damage to the PS.
(7) Wipe off saliva or water drops as soon as possible. Their long time contact with PS causes deformations and color fading.





- For outdoor applications, the EPD module is imported into WTWF to support operation at higher temperature up to 65C and lower temperature to -15C.
- Regarding the WDU test sequence, we do not expect to be able to achieve general performance consistently.
- The purpose of 1bit WTWF is to ensure EPD function and keep clear information.

Waveform mode support

- **Waveform mode support for wide temp**

MODE 0 = INIT (0 to 50C)

MODE 1 = WDU (-15C to 65C), 1bit only

MODE 2 = GC16 (0 to 50 C), 4bit

- Only WDU is rated for use from -15 to +65 C
- GC16 and INIT are only valid from 0 to 50 C, If used outside the range, the display will update and the image quality will be very poor

- **Recommended Usage Mode**

- WDU : Image (A) → Black(WDU) → White(WDU) → Image (B)
 - *Image A can be graytone and Image B can only contain Black and White
 - *To insert additional black & white image between image (A)(B) is needed at high/low temperature to remove ghosting
 - More black & white image can have better ghosting performance
- GC16 : Image (A) → Image (B)
 - *Image A and Image can be 4bit grayscale

- **The terminology of WF mode**

- WDU : WDU is very similar to DU except temperature range is -15 to +65C
1bit, Black/White, no flashing (direct transition)
